With regards to terrorism and extremism in the region, Dr. Sajadpour explained: "terrorists and individuals associated to extremist groups have a



very low understanding of Islam and in most instances they do not have any ideas about this religion." ### **Projects**

### **Prevention of Domestic Violence and Life Skills Training Project**

Ao rding to the tripartite agreement between the ODVV, UNHCR and BAFIA the Prevention of Domes ic Violene and Life Sk Ils Edua tion Projet began on in May 2017 and is due to finish in September.

This projet has been designed for 80 Afghan refugees (40 men and 40 women) in the 12 to 59 age

group and with the aim of reducing o ic all and mental abuse, incleasing of If-belief, and prevention of domestic iv olene among Afghans residing in the Varamin district.

Also in iv ew of:

1-the need for this community to learn domestic violence prevention and reduction methods, 2-extensive positive response of refugees from previous conducted projects, and 3-the need to further exp and these trainings to more vulnerable regions (substantial as Varamin; this project was designed. Base don'the field visits and interviews that took place with the refugees and varamin, where the soic all and mental abuse levels—particularly domestic violence—are very high, while brings about irreversible one quenes that include rise in addition, soic designed arrious soic all damages. This some issue made the ODVV to pursoe the holding of neess or ry training one of the ly for the third one of the varamin and soburbs districts.

Also 80 direct beneficiaries of the project who will be trained as P2P in life skills and violence prevention methods, will each transfer what they have learned to 5 of their peers, which ultimately will see 400 Afghan refugees that are trained in the prevention and reduction of domestic violence.

Commemoration of International Days

# Commemoration of the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women

On the occasion of the International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women and with the cooperation of ODVV Raha Rehabilitation Centre, UNIC and Relief International,



on 25 November the ODVV held a series of educational sittings on a new perspective on intervention, prevention, reduction and treatment of gender based violence (GBV) "interview, diagnosis and treatment of GBV models" in a three-day education workshop with presentation of international certificates of attendance, on the occasion of the International Day of Non-violence.

The three-day workshop began with the reading of the UN Secretary General's message for the day by Mohammad Rajaee Moghadam, representative from UNIC in Iran. The participants included a number of jurists, lawyers, NGOs and human rights activists.

Support and emergency intervention methods for controlling violence, prevention of GBV methods, different types of violence, pathology of the meaning of violence and its related concepts, GVB creating social and cultural beliefs, psychological views on the definition of GBV, the connection between upbringing and parenting methods in relation with GBV, personality, mood and anxiety disorders in relation with GBV, preventative emergency intervention, were some of the important subjects of discussion of the first two days of the workshop which were discussed by Seyed Ahmadreza Salamati, the ODVV Rehabilitation Department Deputy.

Also the review of the most important prevention and treatment of the victims and perpetrators of GBV methods and case based intervention and with the help of practice and role playing were some of the important topics of the third day of the workshop which was discussed by Dr. Jaleh Afshari Monfared, the technical head of the Raha Rehabilitation Centre.



### Commemoration of the international Day in Support of Torture Victims

The technical sitting in support of victims of torture was held on the occasion of the International Day in Support of Victims of Torture on 26 June at the conference hall of the ODVV and the presence of psychologists and psychotherapists and social workers, and with the aim of teaching interview and rehabilitation of torture victims techniques.

The training of therapists for helping victims of torture to return to normal lives and support counselling were some of the important education headings of this technical sitting. Also the facilitator of the workshop, Dr. Jaafari described the logical confronting of the past and acceptance of the present in two headings, in the treatment of torture victims and said, "For treating torture victims the cognitive therapy, behavioural and psychoanalytical methods can be used. Of course the best therapy is team therapy where as well as the therapist, there are also a social worker and psychiatrist present."

### Participation in the 36th Session of the Human Rights Council

The 36th Seis on of the Human Rights Counc I took plae on 11-29 September 2017 at the UN European Headquarters in Genea, Switze rland. The most important activities of the ODVV in this Seis on include:

- Organization of the participation of 6 Iranian NGOs in Consultative Status in the Session As one of the most important human rights institutions in the international order, the Human Rights Council provides good opportunities for NGOs to have a platform and play a role; where often these opportunities turn into ompetitions between organizations For this reason further benefiting from these opportunities is very important. Thus, one of the main activities of the ODVV in the 36th Seson was the arranging the participation of 6 Iranian NGOs in Consultative Status. This activity was done in two stages. Tehran and Geneval, through while the following actions

were taken: identifiation of a mpanying NGOs their registration through the new Councl em, registration for reading oral statements and preparation of 12 oral statements and their reading at the Councl Seiston.

- Preparation of Written Statements and their Submission and their Registration in the Council's Directory

One of the ekt ing opportunities at the Human Rights Councl for NGOs to play a role is the regist ration of written to atements in the Councl's directory whith its post ble is a the Councl website. - Preparation of Thematic Strategic Report and Handing in the Council Session

With the efforts of ODVV experts and through expense to the session on a thematic to the respect of human rights and the dometric and international interests of the Islamic Republic of Iran:

### ■ "Sanctions tantamount to violation of human rights"

The issue of unilateral sanctions imposed against Iran has been one of the focal subjects of the ODVV in its research and executive activities. Thus, following a study of various fields related to the sanctions issue that include: the banking sector, medicines and treatment, industries, development and the economy, in this stage a report on the effects of sanctions on the medicine and treatment sector entitled "sanctions, tantamount to the blatant violation of human rights: thematic study of the effects of sanctions on the supplies of medicines in the Iranian society, was prepared. Attention to the fact that this report was getting prepared by a domestic NGO, the views of the general public, the experiences of manufacturers and importers of medicines and media information was utilised in preparation of the contents of the report. Considering the lack of sufficient statistical data in this regard, through documentation and analysis of existing data efforts were made to have the contents of the report be strong and persuasive. This, is the first issue of a series of ODVV productions regarding the "effects of sanctions on the people of Iran", which is towards the production of scientific literature in the international language with regards to the human rights situation in Iran.

### - Preparation of oral statements and their reading in the Session





# Practical Workshop on the Launching of Data Bank for the Registration of Cases in Rehabilitation Centres

To bring cohesion to victims of torture and violence related data, and also providing assistance to centres active in the field, IRCT through a global project has taken steps to prepare and design a data bank entitled Data in the Fight Against Impunity, for the purpose of registration of the information of cases that have gone to these centres. This workshop was held from 3 to 6 May 2017 in Amman the capital of Jordan with the aim of participation for the fight against impunity through the collection of necessary data from torture victims and towards the accountability, prevention and treatment of these individuals. Participating in this meeting were centres from Iraq, Iran (ODVV), Jordan, Palestine, Lebanon and Morocco. Also the special objective of this project is the strengthening and coordination of the capacities of rehabilitation centres to collect clinical psychological data and the use of the results and outputs for human rights activities and fight against impunity. This data bank has been launched with the cooperation of various centres from the abovementioned countries, and recently its second version which has corrected the problems of the first version have been launched in the centres of these countries and are being used. The IRCT's programme is to bring about conditions where all its members benefit from this data bank.

### Participation in the 34th Session of the Human Rights Council



### - Publication and Distribution of Specific Books, Journals, Annual Reports and Multimedia Products



Towards this action, the table of the sidelines panels were studied and the some of these panels which were more in line with the work field of the ODVV were selected and from a pre-planned programme, the experts took part in these panels and prepared full reports.



# Rehabilitation Department: Raha Counselling Centre

With a wish to mend and end mankind's pains and sufferings, and expansion of humanitarian campaigns, the ODVV Rehabilitation Department provides advisory and educational services. For the protection of victims of domestic and social violence, the department presents counselling and therapy in legal, family, marriage, psychological disorders at the Rehabilitation Centre. With the cooperation



of 40 mental health experts and lawyers the Centre provides pre-marriage, education and legal counselling. The statistics of the cases is determined on the basis of gender, age, occupation, marital status, education levels and the reason for coming to the Centre. The ODVV uses the results of the statistics to set appropriate programmes and projects. In 2017, 3962 cases benefited from the Centre's services. 2050 of them were women and 1912 were men. According to the statistics most of the cases were married and the majority of them had family problems.

The Raha Counselling Centre also provides telephone hotline counselling services for psychological, marital, family and education issues via telephone hotline.

Fundamental skills related to the subject of violence education, social facilitation for getting skills for social oriented interventions to utilise popular potentials to prevent physical, mental, sexual and economic abuse were the most important subjects of this training course which were taught over four days to two groups of 35 individuals. In the opening and closing ceremonies of the workshop, officials from the Tehran and Astan Khorasan Razavi Judiciary were present as guest speakers.

### **Education Workshop on Freudian Psychotherapy: from Theory to Practice in Therapy**

The one-day Education Workshop on Freudian Psychotherapy: from Theory to Practice in Therapy Session was held on 9 May, 2017 in the conference hall of the ODVV.

This one-day workshop that was entitled the "psychoanalytical approach for improvement through dialogue in various pathologies, was held with the presence of Jean-Luc Vernier, psychotherapist and Nice University professor and 30 psychiatrists, psychotherapists and psychologists.

The following topics were taught comprehensively and in detail to the audience:

- 1 -To explain the consequences of the discovery by Sigmund Freud of the primacy of the radical otherness in the creation of the unconscious and that of the human sexuality;
- 2 studying through the historical background of psychoanalysis, the major concepts, always referring to the clinical basis;
- 3 A thorough understanding of psychoanalysis and psychology in order to better assess the functioning of the human psyche, its desire, its identity and its place in the social group; and 4 To give clinicians many efficient means in their daily work.

Also the participants of this workshop were introduced to discussions such as: a method of treatment of the neurotic disorders, presentation and exegesis of the psychoanalysis, from early childhood to adolescence, the cataclysm of puberty and the various adolescent addictions, a process of investigation of the psychic processes, the basic rules of the analytic session, conditions for the commencing of therapy session, The Freudian "setting": from the face to face to the sofa. How? Why?, The differences between psychiatry, psychology and psychoanalysis, the fundamental situation of anthropology according to professor John Le Planch theory, trauma, sudden developments, and various addictions among youths, physical comfort.



### The Raha Counselling Centre also in 2017 had the following activities in its working agenda:




